**Award of the 911 Performance Audit Contract**

**911 Performance Audit** – Chris Clarke, Post Auditor, briefed the committee on staff's analysis and rankings of the two audit bids submitted. Brevitz Consulting Services and Bauknight, Pietras, & Stormer, P.A. are the two firms that submitted bids. Chris said Post Audit staff recommend awarding the engagement to Brevitz Consulting Services based on the firm's overall score across three areas. Both firms have experience with the Kansas 911 system and scored closely in firm qualifications and fee. However, Brevitz Consulting Services scored higher on staff qualifications because they reported more recent experience with performance audits.
